BRIEF OVERVIEW

The Ministry of Education constituted a National Task Force to study mental health issues among students in Higher Education Institutes (HEIs) and to develop preventive measures for reducing stress, anxiety, and suicide risk. As part of this initiative, our colleges were directed to conduct a structured survey among their students. Our college actively participated in this national-level activity to assess students' emotional well-being, academic stress factors, and the need for institutional support systems.

2. Objectives of the Survey

- To understand the mental health status of students in HEIs.
- To identify sources of academic, social, and financial stress.
- To evaluate awareness about counselling services and support mechanisms.
- To assess the risk factors associated with suicidal thoughts/behaviour.
- To promote mental health awareness and create a supportive campus environment.
- To contribute data to the National Task Force for policy planning and preventive strategies.

3. Survey Implementation at College Level

a. Orientation and Awareness

All students were briefed on the purpose and confidentiality of the survey. Faculty members highlighted the importance of honest responses and assured students of privacy.



b. Method of Data Collection

- The survey was conducted using the official questionnaire provided by the National Task Force.
- Responses were collected through online forms.
- Students from UG and PG programs voluntarily participated.
- Faculty from the institute participated
- Faculty coordinators (class teachers) were appointed to monitor and guide the process.

c. Participation Details

- Total Students Participated: Communicated to all under graduate and post graduate students
- Streams Covered: Science / Commerce / PG
- Faculty Coordinators: 40

4. Key Findings

Based on student responses, the following general observations were recorded:

- Many students reported moderate levels of academic stress related to exams, workload, and future career uncertainty.
- A section of students expressed concerns about financial.
- A portion of students were not fully aware of the availability of counselling services or did not feel confident seeking help.
- Social media comparison were identified as additional stressors.
- A very small number of students expressed feelings of hopelessness or self-harm tendencies, highlighting the need for timely intervention.

5. Role of the College

- Conducted awareness on mental health and emotional well-being.
- Ensured safe, confidential, and stigma-free participation.
- Facilitated the survey across all departments.
- Identified students requiring further counselling and directed them to the college counselling cell.
- Submitted the consolidated survey report to the National Task Force as per guidelines.

6. Outcomes of the Activity

- Enhanced student awareness on mental health issues and the importance of seeking help.
- Strengthened the role of the Counselling Cell in addressing emotional challenges.
- Enabled the college to plan targeted interventions like stress-management workshops, mentorship programs, and psychological support.
- Provided valuable data to support the National Task Force in designing preventive policies for HEIs.
